Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General - all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

We will take appropriate steps to promote the four licensing objectives, including hiring SIA licensed security guards during the event, having qualified first aiders on site, easily recognisable volunteer stewards, providing a safe environment with limited vehicles on site, minimising and highlighting and hazards (e.g. trip hazards) with safety/information signage, carrying out necessary risk and fire assessments, and ensuring the event closes promptly at 23:00 and encouraging those attending to leave promptly and quietly to minimise disruption.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

We will have two SIA licensed security guards on site to assist with the prevention of any crime or disorder, assisted by recognisable volunteer stewards. We will be checking ID at the bar and will not serve alcohol to anyone under the age of 18. We will notify the local police of the event.

c) Public safety

The premises is a relatively enclosed and safe site. We will be limiting vehicles on site during the event and any hazards, such as trip hazards, will be minimised and highlighted where necessary with safety/information signage. The site will also be lit during the evening. We will have two SIA licensed security guards and qualified first aiders on site, as well as easily recognisable volunteer stewards.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

The premises is only surrounded by residential housing on the west side, and is otherwise surrounded by fields, allotments and a public car park. The stage and music will be faced away from the residential housing to minimise disruption. The event will close promptly at 23:00 and our security guards and volunteer stewards will help to clear the site quickly and quietly, and we will have signs reminded those attending to be respectful of neighbours.

e) The protection of children from harm

Children are welcome at the event but will require adult supervision. The site is relatively enclosed and safe. ID will be checked at the bar and no alcohol will be served to anyone under the age of 18. There will be no adult entertainment at the event. We will have qualified first aiders and licensed security guards on site, as well as easily recognisable volunteer stewards who will be able to assist children should they require help. Vehicles will be limited on site, any hazards will be highlighted appropriately and the site will be lit in the evening.





 - Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
 - Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
