



GO IN, STAY IN, TUNE IN WYTCH FARM OILFIELD SAFETY CODE

ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN IN AN EMERGENCY

On hearing a loud **SINGLE, STEADY TONE**, siren:

- **Switch off** and abandon any vehicle;
- **Go indoors immediately** - if possible, make sure neighbours/fellow workers/tradesmen are aware;
- **Close** all external doors and windows;
- **Shut off** any ventilation systems;
- **Extinguish** all sources of ignition; turn off gas and electric stoves; cookers and heaters, put out cigarettes, cigars, pipes, put out open fires;
- **Close the curtains** and stay as far away from windows as possible;
- **Stay** in a room facing away from the Gathering Station;
- **Do not use land or mobile telephone** to ensure lines are free for emergency services;
- Tune in to BBC Radio Solent on (FM 96.1, digital radio and online) or check for updates on Dorset Council and Dorset Police's website's
www.dorsetcouncil.gov.uk / www.dorset.police.uk;
wait for instructions from the police -
DO NOT EVACUATE UNLESS ADVISED BY THE POLICE

ALL CLEAR will be via the local radio, posted on Dorset Police's website or will be confirmed in person by Emergency Services. Anyone not in residence at the time, will be stopped by the police from entering the area and directed to a designated centre.

SIREN TESTING

The Public Warning Siren is tested quarterly, usually on the second week of each quarter (January, April, July, October). Notifications are sent to local residents prior to any such test - you do not need to respond to the siren at these times.

SAFETY CODE

- Keep this card in a prominent and easily accessible place;
- Pass on to subsequent occupiers of property;
- Ensure all occupants are familiar with the safety advice and of the actions to be taken;
- Advise any visitors, fellow workers, tradesmen of the public warning siren and of the actions to be taken in the event the siren is sounded.

If you CANNOT go indoors, walk away from the Gathering Station onto the furthest open ground available, but avoiding areas downwind of the Gathering Station. If possible, continue to walk away from the Gathering Station area altogether.
