### Temporary Closure of Public Footpath No 130, Weymouth

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic [Temporary Restrictions] Act 1991. All pedestrians will be prohibited from proceeding along Footpath No 130, from grid reference SY 663 786 to grid reference SY 662 784, a distance of approximately 380 metres. The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on the 1 October 2020, for a period of 26 weeks. But it may be extended, with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport, if necessary.

The order is required to allow construction of domestic housing.

There will be a locally signed diversion in place.

## The Borough of Weymouth and Portland (Waiting Restrictions) (Consolidation) Order 2011 (Order No. 4, 2020) Verne Road, Weymouth – prohibition and restriction of waiting

Dorset Council has made an Amendment Order to 'The Borough of Weymouth and Portland (Waiting Restrictions) (Consolidation) Order 2011' under relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and under Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with statutory requirement and in compliance with The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996.

When the Order comes into operation on 2 October 2020, the effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting between 8am and 6pm along a section of Verne Road, Weymouth. Relevant exemptions will apply where appropriate and as necessary in accordance with the provisions of the Order.
