## NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WEST DORSET DISTRICT COUNCIL WEST DORSET DISTRICT (MELCOMBE HORSEY FOOTPATH 16) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 1987

On 15th February 1988 the West Dorset District Council confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order, as confirmed, is to divert the whole of Melcombe Horsey Footpath 16 which runs from map reference 75480137 on the unclassified County road generally westwards for 1000 metres to map reference 74500145 on Melcombe Horsey Bridleway 8 to a new line running southwestwards from map reference 75480137 for 70 metres, crossing the parish boundary at map reference 75430133 and continuing, as Cheselbourne Footpath 25, southwestwards then westwards for 300 metres along the northern boundary of Field OS 2200, returning to the parish of Melcombe Horsey over a stile at map reference 75150125 into Field OS 9930 and running northwards for 60 metres then west-northwestwards along the northern boundary of that field for 375 metres, then southwestwards for 15 metres, through a gate into Field OS 7458 and, after skirting the northeastern corner of Field OS 7029, entering that field through a further gate and running westwards along its northern boundary for 250 metres and finally southwards for 20 metres to emerge onto Melcombe Horsey Bridleway 8 at map reference 74530138.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, 58/60 High West Street, Dorchester, Dorset, between 9.00 a.m and 4.30 p.m Mondays to Fridays. Copies of the Order and map may be purchased.

The Order becomes operative as from 19th February 1988 but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provisions contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, or of any regulation made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order he may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 19th February 1988 make an application for the purpose to the High Court.

# PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT, 1980 WEST DORSET DISTRICT COUNCIL WEST DORSET DISTRICT (MELCOMBE HORSEY FOOTPATH 16) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER, 1987

WHEREAS it appears to the WEST DORSET DISTRICT COUNCIL as respects the footpath referred to in paragraph 1 of this Order that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the path and the public it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted;

AND WHEREAS the said owner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into operation of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path way into a fit condition for use by the public:

AND WHEREAS the DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL have been consulted in pursuance of section 120(2) of the Highways Act 1980 (hereinafter called 'the 1980 Act');

AND WHEREAS the DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL have consented to the making of this order in pursuance of section 120(2) of the Highways Act, 1980.

NOW THEREFORE the WEST DORSET DISTRICT COUNCIL in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred by section 119 of the 1980 Act hereby make the following order:

- 1. The public right of way over the land situate at Melcombe Horsey in the District of West Dorset shown by a solid black line on the map annexed hereto and described in A of the schedule hereto shall be extinguished at the expiration of twenty-eight days from the date of confirmation of this order.
- 2. Where immediately before the date on which a highway is diverted in pursuance of this order there is apparatus under, in, on, along or across that highway belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
- 3. There shall be at the expiration of twenty-eight days from the date of confirmation of this order a public footpath over the land situate at Melcombe Horsey aforesaid and Cheselbourne in the said District described in B of the schedule hereto and shown by a broken black line on the map contained in this
- 4. This order may be cited as the West Dorset District (Melcombe Horsey Footpath 16) Public Path Diversion Order, 1987


