

## **THE DORSET COUNCIL (ST MARTINS ROAD, UPTON) (SCHOOL STREET) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) (EXPERIMENTAL ORDER) 2022**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of Dorset has made the above-mentioned Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended:

When the Experimental Order comes into operation on the 13<sup>th</sup> June 2022 the effect will be to prohibit driving of motor vehicles in St Martins Road, Upton during the hours 8.15am until 9.30am and 2.30pm until 3.30pm on every school day.

The following exceptions will apply:

- The vehicle is directed by or with the permission of a police officer or Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform.
- The vehicle is being used for emergency services purposes.
- Residents requiring access to their off-street parking facilities.
- The vehicle is displaying an Upton Junior School Permit obtainable from Upton Junior School, on the vehicle's windscreen.
- The vehicle is displaying an access permit obtainable from the Council, on the vehicle's windscreen.
- The vehicle is being used in connection with the laying, erection, alteration, or repair of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984 and cannot conveniently be used for such purposes from any other location.
- The vehicle is being used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and cannot conveniently be used for such purposes from any other location.
- The vehicle is being used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic.

The reasons for proceeding by way of experimental order is to assess the effects of the changes before Dorset Council consider whether the provisions of the experimental traffic order shall continue in force indefinitely.
