Workshop aims

Local Planning Policy

- Encouraging & supporting renewable energy and energy efficiency
- Sustainable housing where less travel
- Support zero carbon newbuild/retro fit,
- Sustainable travel & EV infrastructure, make it a requirement
- Look at barriers for sustainable energy in planning
- Adequate green infrastructure planning policy

Sustainable Transport

- Local transport plan needs to be strengthened
- Smarter working plan methods to encourage less staff travel, work at home etc..
- Investment in sustainable Transport
 network
- Sustainable travel & EV infrastructure
- Affordability of public transport



Some Initial Outcomes

Using our own assets

- Renewable installations, energy
 efficiency / Retrofit of buildings
- Develop & promote exemplars e.g.
 - Zero carbon buildings, County parks, county farm practice /ecology
- Management of our green assets
- Smarter working and planning of building use/location
- Vehicle replacement policy / fleet strategy needed

Green infrastructure

- Green Infrastructure strategy
- Planning policy for green infrastructure
- Ensure links between ecological and climate emergency
- County wildlife sites (SNCIs) need more support



Some Initial outcomes

Engagement / Behaviour change

- Working with / mobilise town and Parish Councils
- Clear communication utilise different technology, approaches and points of contact with the public e.g. services users, schools, NHS
- Raising awareness people in touch with environment, what can do, clear messages, examples

- Sustainable procurement across DC
- Influence MP's via all route and groups
 available
- Ensure future developments/ projects are assessed for impact
- Partnership working e.g. LEP, LNP, Other public sector, town & parish councils
