	Each of the search areas for Stalbridge raise "[p]ossible highways constraints relating to the capacity of the highway network at Stalbridge"; however, the growth of Stalbridge would also impact upon highways capacity issues at Henstridge, and perhaps also at Yenston and Templecombe. Due to the proximity of Stalbridge to South Somerset and the aforementioned settlements, the growth of Stalbridge is a duty to co-operate matter and we would appreciate the ongoing opportunity to discuss your plans for Stalbridge as the Plan progresses.
