Community Action Plan 2010

Vision:

Influence and, in collaboration with partner organisations, manage the development of our community in order to maximise the quality of life and well-being of residents.

Key M.O.

Establish local alliances with towns and parishes to create a sustainable base for finding solutions and delivery mechanisms.

Economic Generation

Goal: A thriving, sustainable local economy.

Action:

- 1. Support initiatives and projects which enhance the local skill base and generate training opportunities through RiversMeet.
- 2. Support Sowing Seeds and encourage local groups to take advantage of the opportunities it offers.
- 3. Through actions within the other five themes, contribute to ensuring that the Gillingham area can attract new businesses able to recruit and retain suitably qualified employees.

Transport

Goal: Improvements in local transport to better meet the needs of local residents.

Action:

- 1. Further develop the network of footpaths and cycleways.
- 2. Support the Gillingham Area Voluntary Car Link Scheme.
- 3. Work with other towns to bring coherence to how local residents can access the services they offer.
- 4. Work with DCC and bus operators to ensure appropriate access to RiversMeet.

Culture, Arts & Sport

Goal: *High quality, accessible facilities to enable participation in cultural, artistic and sporting activities.*

Action:

- 1. Develop and manage sustainable community and leisure facilities on behalf of Gillingham and surrounding communities.
- 2. Work with Sports and Arts organisations in North Dorset to improve provision, promotion and participation and develop a coherent and sustainable strategy for the area.
- 3. Set up an Arts & Culture Forum with the remit to develop the potential of RiversMeet as a Performing Arts venue.

Environment

Goal: Sustainable and managed built and natural environment.

Actions:

- 1. Support the production of a formal Design Statement for Gillingham Town.
- 2. Support neighbouring parishes in their development of complementary Design Statements in order to achieve a coherent vision for the Gillingham area.
- 3. Contribute to the Core Strategy of the emerging Local Development Framework
- 4. Implement the recommendations in the Three Rivers Partnership Open Spaces report (2005)

Social Well-being

Goal: A flourishing, safe, healthy and responsible community.

Action:

- 1. Exploit the new Community Hub as a point of access into statutory and voluntary support organisations.
- 2. Gather evidence to establish the benefits of regular exercise and demonstrate the cost-effectiveness of investment in activities and facilities which promote a healthy life-style.
- 3. Use the new facilities to implement healthy living strategies, particularly targeting young people, older residents, the disabled and the traditionally hard to reach groups.
- 4. Work with Gillingham Town Council to produce a Town Plan for Gillingham which acknowledges and integrates with Parish Plans produced by surrounding communities.
- 5. Work constructively with the Community Planning Team to ensure that community organisations have access to timely and appropriate information, advice and practical support.
- 6. Develop the Three Rivers Community Lottery to provide a source of funding for local organisations, initiatives and projects.
