
North Dorset Local Plan 2011-2026 Part 1 Pre-submission Consultation 29/11/2013 - 24/01/2014.

At both the Cabinet Meeting held on 16th September 2013 and the full Council Meeting held on 27th September, councillors agreed to review their decision to allocate the Crown Meadows at Blandford for development if the other site at St Mary's Hill was brought forward by the landowner. Blandford St. Mary Homes (BSMH), having carried out a public consultation and held a "request for pre planning application advice" meeting with NDDC planning department on 15th January 2014, have now met that condition. Their outline proposal is both sustainable and deliverable.

In order to assist Cabinet and full council in making their decision as to where the necessary homes should be built in Blandford, the Bryanston Park preservation Group (BPPG) carried out a 14 day leaflet survey together with an online "Survey Monkey" survey, asking respondents where they would prefer homes to be built. The questions were clear, transparent and a site location map is attached to the leaflet and the Survey Monkey survey. I enclose a copy of the leaflet and a copy of the survey monkey version of the leaflet in case you have not yet seen them.

A total of 1,013 respondents indicated a preference for option 1, The St Mary's Hill site; 7 respondents preferred the Crown Meadows site and 4 leaflets were spoiled. The original leaflet responses together with a print out accompany this letter. The leaflets are arranged in the order of the print out for ease of audit. The Survey Monkey survey produced 270 responses, 258 for option 1 and 12 for option 2. Print out attached. Taking both surveys together produces 1,271 in favour of Option 1 and 19 in favour of Option 2.

Please bring this overwhelming support for Option 1 to the attention of Cabinet and Full Council when you brief them on the results of this round of consultation. Councillors may then reconsider their unpopular decision to allocate the Crown Meadows for development now that a viable and popular alternative exists.

Plans to build up to 200 houses on beautiful Crown Meadows (Bryanston Deer Park) have been strongly opposed by locals, with almost 6,000 signing our petition. Proposals for an alternative scheme at St. Mary's Hill, Blandford St.Mary (opposite Tesco roundabout) have now been submitted to the Planning Committee showing the viability & sustainability of the site for the development of up to 200 houses in phase one. Councillors have stated that they will reconsider both sites before their final proposal goes to the Secretary of State for approval in the New Year.

Benefits of the St.Mary's Hill scheme include: protecting a site of great natural beauty, minimal visual impact on the town's heritage setting, reducing the likelihood of additional traffic congestion. The location of both sites are clearly shown on the maps on the following pages. You can choose which option you prefer to be developed by ticking one of two tick boxes.




