Thank you for your email of 11 October and attached letter to the Inspector.

The Inspector's response is as follows:-

"It was accepted by all parties that this screening work would be done and that there would be an opportunity to comment. The original time limit was 31 October. As the council asked for an extra six days to complete the screening work in the light of time constraints, an additional 14 days has been allowed for comments - thus extending the time limit to 14 November to ensure fairness. This information is already on the council's website.

It should also be noted that any main modifications to the plan would inevitably have to be consulted on and the screening addendum will be available during this consultation period as well; the examination does not close until the final inspector's report is issued.

The Inspector considers this to be the appropriate way forward in fairness to all interested parties."
