Split landbanks for sand and gravel are used elsewhere in the UK and there may be merit in Dorset adopting this approach to ensure continued supplies of Poole Formation which is stated in the Mineral Strategy to be the area's most important source of sand. The 2016 draft LAA indicates that for the past 17 years sales from Poole Formation sources have consistently been greater than those from River Terrace. Meanwhile there is a known landbank shortage of Poole Formation reserves compared to those from River Terrace.
