Sherborne Area Partnership Report 2016-17 for WDP

In accordance with the SLA here is a report from Sherborne Area Partnership as follows:-

PERFORMANCE INDICATORS

- a) There are 8 partners engaged in the work of the local partnership.
- b) 3 consultations undertaken and 50 approx. consultees involved.
- c) 3 local priorities identified with targets to address them.
- d) One community plan target delivered (HWB Fair).
- e) 380 approx. volunteer hours for partnership planning and project delivery. (3 officers, 8 volunteers attending meetings and averaging 2 hours each per week on related activities).
- f) 16 partnership or collaborative meetings and training sessions attended with other local partnerships including attendance at West Dorset Partnership and SAP AGM.
- g) We have not calculated a figure for the amount of external funding brought into the area.

SERVICE DELIVERY OUTCOMES

- a) Engagement of the local community in consultations about local priorities services and projects (Buses, CSR and Unitary).
- b) Delivery to defined targets that meet identified local priorities Employment Hub, Dementia Friendly and HWB.
- c) Appropriate involvement of the local community in community projects Sherborne HWB Fair 2016.
- d) Networking, shared learning and collaborative project delivery between local organisations and between other local partnerships, where appropriate. Rendezvous, Sherborne Town Council, Dementia Friendly Alliance.
- e) Identification, planning and progression of cross-cutting community priorities through the West Dorset Partnership. SAP has been represented at 4 WDP meetings.

MONITORING AND ASSESSMENT

The Funder will receive end of year accounts from the funding recipient (Dorset Community) in due course.

CHANGES IN CIRCUMSTANCES

- Funding from Sherborne Town Council ended on 31st March 2016 and in effect 3 SAP workers were made redundant.
- From June 2016 service delivery has been facilitated by Dorset Community Action, providing, on average 3 hours per week direct support for SAP. A new chair was elected in September 2016.
- Clearly a reduction in funding for SAP has led to, a considerable reduction in activity and overall delivery.

PUBLICITY AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF SUPPORT
