

# **Dorchester Community Forum**

# Key activities/achievements since September 2018

## **Health and Well-being**

- Development of mental health support projects with MIND, particularly for young people including:
  - Funding and helping set up a drop in mental health group for sixth formers at Thomas Hardye School (started September 2018) (Called Mind, Food & Mood)
  - Funded and helped to set up a support group for young people not attending school which will be based at Shire Hall (starting October 2018) (Called Connected Minds – CM)
  - o Funding development of a mental health support directory for young people.
  - Supporting and promoting setting up an evening support group for young people (starting September)
  - Linking Dorchester Family Partnership Zone and Dorset MIND to run projects together particularly CM group.
- Set up working group to improve social prescribing and better working partnership between health professionals and voluntary sector focussing on promoting the use of the environment to improve health and wellbeing. Several partners involved including: The Local Nature Partnership, Live Well Dorset, the Mid-Dorset Clinical Commissioning Group and Stepping into Nature.
   This culminated in a Health and Wellbeing picnic in Borough Gardens on Sat 8 September which involved the above organisations along with a range of community organisations such as the Dorchester Strollers and the Dorchester Disabled Club. A second event and other related activities are planned for 2019 to link into the self-management and social prescribing strategy that is being developed by the Dorset CCG.
- Ongoing support for the Dorchester Access Group including:
  - Commenting on Access issues around town and requests for dropped kerbs successfully
    enabled provision of 3 pairs of dropped kerbs in Normandy Avenue area greatly improving
    access across a housing development that previously had no dropped kerbs.
  - Working on developing an Access Guide for Dorchester have over 30 local businesses signed up for this and are currently looking to do more partnership work with People First Dorset.

#### **Environment**

- Support to signage project to improve signage for town.
- Helping to develop a plan for Dorchester to obtain 'Plastic Free' status Town Council are supporting an initiative driven by local primary school to reduce use of plastic across the town

#### Arts and culture

- Member of Inside Out Dorset festival planning committee (provided advice/help with funding, input to their access guide and event support).
- Continued work on Try This website to ensure this project continues aiming to run events in 2019
- Organised/supported additional events including the Dorchester Carnival

#### Housing

Ongoing support for Dorchester Area Community Land Trust.

## Young people

- Support to Dorchester Youth Council
  - This group ran a 'Votes for Women' event in Borough Gardens 01/07/18 which involved several speakers, performers and activities to celebrate 100 years since the introduction of suffrage for women.
- Democracy Day
  - o Ran 2 Democracy Day events involving 2 local middle schools on 20/11/17 & 19/09/18.
    - second event was run in partnership with Shire Hall and a UK Parliamentary
       Outreach officer
- Coordination of Dorchester Youth Extra youth forum for Dorchester
  - o Group meet monthly and get involved in local consultations and projects
  - o Ran 2 signature events in 2018:
    - Anonymous Festival 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of this popular family festival approximately 2000 attendees.
    - Open Air Cinema event approximately 4000 attendees.

## Community cohesion, consultations, funding, advice & information

- Ran 3 Community Lunches with average of 60 attendees per event
- Involved local community and set up focus groups for several local consultations including:
  - Jubilee Hall usage at Poundbury
  - Development of Great Field at Poundbury
  - o Local Plan review
  - o Town Centre Masterplan
- Work with Chamber of Business for Dorchester to find ways to support the community/voluntary sector – Chamber are holding a sponsorship breakfast in November to link local businesses to local groups
- Coordinated/Co-organised organise events to promote social inclusion including:
  - Holocaust Memorial Day
  - o One World multicultural celebration
  - o Faith Communities Together event bringing range of faith organisations together

## **Future work**

- Ongoing support, advice, partnership working with several local organisations including the Dorchester Family Partnership Zone, the County Museum and Shire Hall
- Allotments project scoping whether there is excess allotment produce that could be directed to people in food poverty link to existing food projects including local Foodbank.
- Helping establish more pop-up shops in town
- Running a fundraising 'community soup' event
- Continued support/advocacy for involvement of the voluntary sector in Local Government Reorganisation – particularly in relation to community planning and delivery and funding/support for community/voluntary sector
- Continuing to ensure community voice is enabled regarding town centre planning and Local Plan proposals
- Scoped project to develop more Business Hub space
- Achieve 'Plastic Free' status for Dorchester
- Developing a financial advice pack for young people.
- Delivery of several large-scale events including:
  - o An event to celebrate Homecoming after World War One November 2018
  - o A 'scooter jam' at the Skate Park to celebrate its 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary April 2019
  - o An event to celebrate the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the lunar landing July 2019
