Gill Smith CON/16/7 - missing text Question 6

Dorset County Council notes the increase in housing identified in this change.

However, it should be noted that the Library service is already undersized (for the population) and not "fit for future" population pressures. Any increase in the town's population will have an impact on provision of library services and the following considerations must be made when there is an increase in population:

- a) longer opening hours for the current library to enable more people to use the facility;
- b) increased books and other stock and public access computers;
- c) extended provision of access to e-books and e-resources, offering virtual access. This will be reliant on a good broadband service to the area;
- d)increased usage will increase the frequency of the need to refurbish the library;
- e) the need to replace the library (it is not possible to extend in Blandford.)

The above factors will require additional resources to provide these services/facilities for a larger population. The expectation is that this will be accounted for in the Infrastructure Delivery Plan and included in the Community Infrastructure Levy.
