a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 9)
We shall ensure that, at all times, there are sufficient competent staff on duty at the premises for the purpose of fulfilling the terms and conditions of the licence and for preventing crime and disorder. Selected Grapes Ltd will ensure that all staff will undertake training in their responsibilities in relation to the sale of alcohol, particularly with regard to drunkenness and underage persons. Records will be kept of training and refresher training.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

We will ensure effective and responsible management of premises, Training and supervision of staff, Adoption of best practice guidance.

Any incidents of a criminal nature that may occur on the premises will be reported to the Police.

c) Public safety

Provision of a sufficient number of people employed or engaged to secure the safety of the premises and patrons. Appropriate instruction, training and supervision of those employed with adoption of best practice guidance.

Appropriate fire safety procedures are in place including fire extinguishers (H20 and CO2) and fire blanket. All appliances are inspected annually. All emergency exits shall be kept free from obstruction at all times.

d) The prevention of public nuisa

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All customers will be asked to leave quietly. We will collect and dispose of litter.

e) The protection of children from harm

The licensee and staff will ask persons who appear to be under the age of 25 for photographic ID such as proof of age cards, the Connexions Card and Citizen Card, photographic driving licence or passport, an official identity card issued by HM Forces or by an EU country, bearing the photograph and date of birth of bearer. All staff will be trained for underage sales prevention regularly. A register of refused sales shall be kept and maintained on the premises.
