

1. Statement of Representations Procedure

- 1.1 The Council has published a Draft Charging Schedule for consultation under Regulation 16 of The Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations 2010 (as amended).
- 1.2 **The consultation period is from 17th June 2016 to 4.00pm on 29th July 2016.** Representations received after this date or anonymous representations will not be considered. Representations must therefore include a contact name and address (e-mail and/or postal). Providing a contact telephone number would also be helpful.

- 1.6 Please note that any comments submitted will not be confidential and will be made publicly available but address and contact details will not be shown online.
- 1.7 Any person making representations on the Draft Charging Schedule may request the right to be heard by the examiner as part of the examination of the Draft Charging Schedule. Anyone who wishes to be heard must make a request to North Dorset District Council by the end of the consultation period. There is tick box on the

consultation response form which allows representors to indicate that they wish to be heard.

1.8 Representations may also be accompanied by a request to be notified, at a specified address, of any of the following:

- that the draft charging schedule has been submitted to the examiner in accordance with section 212 of the PA 2008;
- the publication of the recommendations of the examiner and the reason for those recommendations; and
- the approval of the charging schedule by the charging authority.
