No follow-up on Bat surveys done has been received from CC.

Bat survival would be in jeopardy due to - Loss of the farm and livestock, their feeding and roosting habitat. Incompatibility with conversion of old barn to a village hall. Owls, Cuckoos, House Martins and other wildlife could also be affected by the loss of feeding and roosting habitat.
