Thank you for consulting the Agency on your proposed modification to your CIL charging schedule. The Agency would support the increase of the rate per sqm for dwellings in Chickerell and Crossways to £100 (from £80). Proposed growth in these locations, particularly at Crossways, is likely to impact on the strategic road network (ie the A35 and its junctions) and mitigation will be required to support that growth.
