THE BOROUGH OF WEYMOUTH AND PORTLAND

ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION IN PUBLIC PLACES DESIGNATION ORDER

The Borough Council of Weymouth and Portland (in this Order called "the Council") hereby make the following Order for regulating alcohol consumption in designated places:-

- Any place identified in the Schedule below, being a public place in the area of the Council, is hereby designated in accordance with Section 13 of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 for the purposes of Part I of that Act.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Weymouth and Portland Alcohol Consumption in Public Places Designation Order and shall come into force on 6th April 2002 as from which date the Byelaws for the Consumption of Intoxicating Liquor in Designated Places made on the 28th February 2000 and confirmed on 12th April 2000 are hereby revoked.
- 3. The effect of this Order shall be that the Police have a power to require a person in a designated public place not to drink alcohol in that place where the Police Officer reasonably believes that the person is, has or intends to do so and to surrender any alcohol or alcohol containers (other than sealed containers) in a person's possession. Failure to comply with a Police Officer's requirement in respect of public drinking or surrender of alcohol, without reasonable excuse, is an arrestable offence. A person guilty of such an offence will be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding Level 2 (currently £500).


