Wyatt Homes supports the Council's statement that the Blandford + Neighbourhood Plan as amended meets the basic conditions, is compatible with the Convention rights and complies with the definition of a neighbourhood development plan.

The Blandford+ Neighbourhood Plan has been subject to a careful and thorough examination by a highly qualified and experienced independent Examiner. The Examiner has given particular attention to Policy B2 of the Neighbourhood Plan, which allocates land north and east of Blandford for a residential-led mixed-use development.

The Examiner has found that Policy B2:

- Is fully in accordance with the strategic policy and guidance in the Local Plan.
- Provides infrastructure needed to support the town.
- Makes an important contribution to meeting housing, employment and community needs.
- Meets the national policy presumption in favour of sustainable development.
- Reflects a continued process of community involvement.
- Is supported by a detailed and comprehensive sustainability appraisal including consideration of alternatives sites.
- Represents the best location for meeting the housing, employment, and education needs of the Blandford area.
- Will help to improve the housing land supply situation in the North Dorset area.
- Accords with national planning policy on development within the AONB.

Wyatt Homes considers that the Blandford+ Neighourhood Plan should be commended for its forward thinking and pragmatic approach in identifying a future direction of growth for the Blanfdord area that respects its environmental constraints, supports its role, function and identity, and enables Blandford to maintain its role as the main service centre in this part of the county.

Wyatt Homes advocate a referendum on the Blandford + Neighbourhood Plan as soon as the relevant legislation and supporting regulations allow.
