I am supporting Chickerell Town Council on their Neighbourhood Plan.

Matt Low kindly provided the attached SEA screening response to West Dorset District Council (now part of Dorset Council) in March, which dealt with whether the Chickerell Neighbourhood Plan might need an SEA (the conclusion being that no it didn't). The SEA screening request didn't however deal with whether there might be a need for an HRA – and although Matt's conclusions would imply that this would be unlikely (as Matt's conclusions were that "the proposals contained within the plan will not have significant effects on sensitive sites that Natural England has a statutory duty to protect" and "that, in so far as our strategic environmental interests (including but not limited to statutory designated sites, landscapes and protected species, geology and soils) are concerned, that there are unlikely to be significant environmental effects from the proposed plan") it would be useful to have a definitive statement from yourselves whether this applies equally to the European sites in reference to the HRA triggers.
