

## CHRISTCHURCH AND EAST DORSET CORE STRATEGY PROPOSED MAIN MODIFICATIONS TO PRE-SUBMISSION CORE STRATEGY

**Statement of Representations Procedure** – following the Submission of the Pre-Submission Core Strategy to the Secretary of State in March 2013 for examination and the subsequent Hearing Sessions conducted by an independent Planning Inspector, between the 10<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> September 2013, the Inspector has identified some key areas which she considers need to be modified to help make the plan sound. The Inspector has invited the Councils to consult on these before she issues her final report.

**Subject matter and area covered by the document** - The Core Strategy (Local Plan) is the document that sets out the planning strategy for Christchurch Borough and East Dorset District over the next 15 years. It sets out how much, what type, where and how development should take place and how this should be catered for. It sets out a vision and objective for the area which are reflected in planning policies to achieve this.

**Period for Representations** – The consultation period runs from **Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2013 to 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2014** (6 weeks) and representations received after 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2014 will not be accepted.
