The Core Strategy Issues and Options What is the Core Strategy?

The Core Strategy forms a key part of the new Local Development Framework (LDF), which will eventually replace the Local Plans for Christchurch & East Dorset.

The Core Strategy sets out the vision and development strategy for how we want the area to develop over the next 20 years. It will cover key issues such as housing, economic growth, protecting our environment and supporting local communities.

It is an important document and we want the community to get involved in its preparation.

A Joint Document - Christchurch and East Dorset Councils are producing the Core Strategy jointly. The document will cover both Councils areas.

The Process - The Core Strategy will be progressed through two consultation stages, after which new policies will be drafted and a Core Strategy will be submitted to the Government for approval.

The draft document will be submitted in March 2009 and adopted by June 2010.







Issues and Options

The first stage of preparing the Core Strategy is known as 'Issues & Options'. This does exactly what it says, in that we are seeking to find out what issues the Core Strategy needs to address, and the possible options for addressing those issues.

Identifying The Issues

By reviewing the Community Plans in Christchurch and East Dorset, and from issues which are raised within and outside the Councils, we have identified a series of themes which the Core Strategy needs to address.

The Issues and Options paper identifies a series of issues questions on each theme, and then suggests a number of options for addressing the issues.

The Themes identified include:

- Delivering Suitable and Sufficient Housing.
- Natural Environment Constraints.
- Town Centre Vitality.
- Transport Improvements
- Development in the Green Belt
- Sustainable economic growth
- Addressing Climate Change
- Crime and Community Safety
