THE DORSET COUNCIL (SHORE ROAD, SWANAGE) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) (EXPERIMENTAL ORDER) 2022

Dorset Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

DURATION, MODIFICATION AND SUSPENSION

- 1 'The County of Dorset (Shore Road, Swanage) (Traffic Management) Order 1984 and all subsequent amendments and variations are hereby suspended while this order is in force.
- 2 This Order shall cease to have effect 18 months after it comes into operation or when a further Order to reproduce and continue in force indefinitely the provision of this Experimental Order is made, whichever is earliest.
- 3 The Dorset Council Traffic Manager may modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provision of it if it appears to them essential:
 - In the interests of the expeditious, convenient, and safe movement of traffic.
 - In the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities.
 - c. For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs.
- The restrictions imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or any other enactment.

INTERPRETATION

In this Order the following expressions shall have the respective meanings assigned to them:

"the 1988 Act" means the Road Traffic Act 1988;

"Motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in the 1988 Act and includes any part of a vehicle.

PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

Save as provided in Article 7 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven on the length of Shore Road, Swanage specified in the Schedule to this Order.

EXEMPTIONS

7 Nothing in this Order shall apply to a vehicle in the following circumstances:

- The vehicle is directed by or with the permission of a Police Officer or Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform.
- · The vehicle is being used for emergency services purposes.
- The vehicle has been specifically authorised by Swanage Town Council.
- The vehicle is in the service of Dorset Council being necessarily used in connection with highway maintenance, parking enforcement, waste collection or street cleansing activities in pursuance of statutory powers and duties.
- The vehicle is being used in connection with the laying, erection, alteration, or repair of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984 and cannot conveniently be used for such purposes from any other location.
- The vehicle is being used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and cannot conveniently be used for such purposes from any other location.
- The vehicle is being used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic.
- 8 This Order may be cited as 'The Dorset Council (Shore Road, Swanage) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (Experimental Order) 2022' and shall come into operation on 1st October 2022.
