
This plan is about the important things

Work on more renewable energy and less waste.



We want Dorset people to live in strong and healthy communities.



We will help all people to have strong communities and networks of support.



The Covid Pandemic means that we need to focus our support on the most vulnerable adults and young people.




Our government funding keeps getting smaller so we will support voluntary and charity organisations to help make people's lives better.

The council will look at yearly reports by housing providers with more than 250 homes to make sure people can access the right homes.



The Covid pandemic has made it difficult for housing services so we will work with partners and private owners to have more long-term homes for everyone, and make sure there are affordable homes to buy.



We will carry on looking at how second holiday homes and holiday home rentals affect the use of our housing.



We want to make Dorset a great place to live and work so we need to:



Support new and existing businesses to grow in a sustainable way and then more people can have good jobs.



Make sure people have the training they need to get good jobs.



We will focus on supporting people to do their best but at the same time protect the environment.



The Covid pandemic has enabled more people to work from home and this helps the environment but we need to make broadband better.



We want to be a council that listens to what people say so that we can support them better.



We will make sure we are efficient and accessible for everyone, and make contacting us as simple as possible.
