I understand from North Dorset District Council's website that you are the examiner appointed for the Hazelbury Bryan Neighbourhood Plan. In correspondence from the Council, we have been told that your report is expected by the end of this month, meaning that there will be no associated hearings.

You will probably be aware from your review of the representations submitted on the plan that there is a degree of controversy surrounding the sites selected for allocation and how the evidence / SA has been applied inconsistently. I therefore wonder if there may be merit in exploring these issues more in-depth through hearing sessions, as the issues in question do go to the heart of the plan and compliance with the basic conditions.

I would be interested to know your thoughts on this and whether or not you would consider holding any hearings.
