

# WEST DORSET DISTRICT (Dorchester Footpath 46) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2007

On 14<sup>TH</sup> January 2008 the West Dorset District Council confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the public footpath running from GR SY67319034 (Point B) running south west for 300 metres to GR SY67159019 (point Y), and create an alternative footpath instead on a line running from the said GR SY67319034 (Point B) running east for 13 metres to GR SY67339034 (point C), then south for 24 metres to GR SY67329032 (point D), then south for 28 metres to GR SY67329029 (point F), then south south west for 76 metres to GR SY67289022 (point G), then south south east for 66 metres to join the highway at GR SY67329018 (point H) as shown on the Order map.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the Order may be seen free of charge at The Council Offices, Stratton House, Dorchester from 9.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays. Copies of the Order may be obtained there.

This Order comes into force on the date on which West Dorset District Council certify that the terms of Article 2 of the Order have been complied with but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity, or that or any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under Section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to the Act.

# PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER JAN 2009 TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTA 1990, SECTION 257



This Order is made by West Dorset District Council under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the footpath/bridleway to which this Order relates in order to enable development to be carried out (in accordance with Planning Permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990) namely planning applications 1/E/2002/1898, 1/E/2006/2332, 1/E/1996/0506.

#### BY THIS ORDER:


- 1. The footpath over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be diverted as provided below.
- 2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of the West Dorset District Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached map.
- 3. The diversion of the footpath shall have the effect on the date which West Dorset District Council certify that the terms of Article 2 above have been complied with.
- 4. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
- 5. This Order may be cited as the West Dorset District (Dorchester Footpath 46) Public Diversion Order 2007


