Public Path Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order

Highways Act 1980 Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

Dorset County Council (Parts of Footpaths 11 and 16, Lytchett Matravers at West Park Farm) Public Path Diversion Order 2012

This order is made by Dorset County Council ("the Authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the lines of the paths should be diverted.

This order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Dorset County Council definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Mr Peter & Mrs Alison Dyball have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the paths into a fit condition for use by the public.

Purbeck District Council has been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public rights of way over the land situate at West Park Farm, Lytchett Matravers and shown by bold continuous lines on the maps contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 7 days from the date of confirmation of this order and thereupon the Dorset County Council definitive map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
- 2. Notwithstanding this order Southern Gas Networks and Scottish and Southern Energy shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 namely: full and free access for purposes connected to the use and maintenance of their apparatus now existing under, over or on the land referred to in paragraph 1.
- 3. There shall at the end of 7 days from the date of confirmation of this order be public footpaths over the land situate at West Park Farm, Lytchett Matravers described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this order and shown by bold broken lines on the maps contained in this order and thereupon the Dorset County Council definitive map shall be modified by adding those paths to it.

- 4. The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule to this order.
- 5. The Dorset County Council definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this order.

SCHEDULE

Part 1

Description of site of existing paths

Footpaths in the parish of Lytchett Matravers in the Purbeck District:

Part of Footpath 11, Lytchett Matravers (Drawing 11/01/4)

From a point 25 metres west north west of its junction with the unclassified road north of Old Park Farm at point A (SY 93069559), across several fields, generally west and south west to point B (SY 92639553), west north west crossing an access track at point C (SY 92589554) and then west south west to point D (SY 92509552).

Parts of Footpath 16, Lytchett Matravers (Drawing 11/01/3)

- From its junction with Colehill Road east of West Park Farm at point H (SY 93319644), south west, on the north western side of the south eastern field boundary and across the next field boundary to point I (SY 93209630).
- 2. From its junction with a farm track south east of West Park Farm at point J (SY 93049609), south west alongside the track to point K (SY 9302796063) and then generally west south west, through Phillip's Coppice and through a field to point L (SY 92469588), south south west of West Park Farm.

Part 2

Description of site of new paths

Footpaths in the parish of Lytchett Matravers in the Purbeck District:

Part of Footpath 11, Lytchett Matravers (Drawing 11/01/4)

From the existing route of Footpath 11 at a point 25 metres west north west of its junction with the unclassified road north of Old Park Farm at point A (SY 93069559), west north west across a field to its north western corner, crossing the field boundary alongside a field gate at point E (SY 92829568), then continuing along the farm track west north west to point F (SY 92809568), then south west to point G (SY 92529552) and west to rejoin the existing route of Footpath 11 at point D (SY 92509552). The width of this part of Footpath 11 is 2 metres.

Parts of Footpath 16, Lytchett Matravers (Drawing 11/01/3)

From its junction with Colehill Road east of West Park Farm at point H (SY 93319644), south west, on the south eastern side of the north western field boundary to point M (SY 93229631) and then south west across the adjacent field boundary to rejoin the existing route of Footpath 16 at point I (SY 93209630).

2. From its junction with a farm track south east of West Park Farm at point J (SY 93049609), south west along the track to point Q (SY 9302396064), then north west into Phillip's Coppice at point R (SY 93019606) and continuing along the edge of the Coppice, north west to point S (SY 92999607) and west south west to its junction with the farm track at point T (SY 92779599). Continue along the farm track, north west via point U (SY 9276795994) to point O (SY 9276195997) and then generally south west to point P (SY 92729595) and west south west to rejoin the existing part of Footpath 16 at point L (SY 92469588), south south west of West Park Farm.

The width of these parts of Footpath 16 is 2 metres.

Continue south west to the Morden parish boundary at its junction with Bridleway 6, Morden.

Then south west along the track to SY 9302396064, north west into Phillip's Coppice at SY 93019606 and continuing along the edge of the Coppice, north west to SY 92999607 and west south west to its junction with the farm track at SY 92779599. Continue along the farm track, north west via SY 9276795994 to SY 9276195997 and then generally south west to SY 92729595 and west south west to SY 92469588 and continue to its junction with Footpath 3. Morden at the Morden parish boundary at Cockett Hill Gate.

The width of the parts of Footpath 16 from SY 93319644 to SY 93209630 and from SY 93049609 to SY 92469588 is 2 metres.

Limitations (all to British Standard BS5709:2006): Pedestrian gates SY 93319644 and SY 93229631; Field gates at SY 92729595 and SY 9276795994; 1 metre wide gap at SY 93019606.
