

**THE DORSET COUNCIL (BARNES WAY, DORCHESTER)
(SCHOOL STREET) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES)
(EXPERIMENTAL ORDER) 2023**

Dorset Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

DURATION, MODIFICATION AND SUSPENSION

- 1 This Order shall cease to have effect 18 months after it comes into operation or when a further Order to reproduce and continue in force indefinitely the provision of this Experimental Order is made, whichever is earliest.
- 2 The Dorset Council Traffic Manager may modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provision of it if it appears to them essential:
 - a) in the interests of the expeditious, convenient, and safe movement of traffic,
 - b) in the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities,
 - c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs.
- 3 Where a provision of this Order is in conflict with a provision contained in a previous order; the provisions of this Order shall prevail for the period that this Order is in force.

INTERPRETATION


- 4 In this Order the following expressions shall have the respective meanings assigned to them:

"Access Permit" means a permit issued at the discretion of the Council to allow access to lengths of roads that are otherwise subject to the restriction.

"Restricted hours" means the periods between 8.15am until 9.15am and 2.45pm until 3.45pm on every school day.

"the 1988 Act" means the Road Traffic Act 1988;

"Motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in the 1988 Act and includes any part of a vehicle.



PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

- 5 Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle during the restricted hours to enter into or proceed on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

EXEMPTIONS

- 6 Nothing in this Order shall apply to a vehicle in the following circumstances:
- (a) The vehicle is directed by or with the permission of a police officer or Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform.
 - (b) The vehicle is being used for emergency services purposes.
 - (c) The vehicle is displaying an access permit obtainable from the Council, on the vehicle's windscreen.
 - (d) The vehicle is being used in connection with the laying, erection, alteration, or repair of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984 and cannot conveniently be used for such purposes from any other location.
 - (e) The vehicle is being used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and cannot conveniently be used for such purposes from any other location.
 - (f) The vehicle is being used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic.
 - (g) Residents requiring access or egress.
- 7 This Order may be cited as 'The Dorset Council (Barnes Way, Dorchester) (School Street) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (Experimental Order) 2022 and shall come into operation on the 6th March 2023.

Schedule 1 – PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

Location	Description	Restricted hours
Barnes Way, Dorchester	From its junction with Rothesay Road in a northerly direction for approximately 170 meters.	8.15am until 9.15am 2.45pm until 3.45pm on every school day.
Barnes Way, Dorchester	From its junction with Rothesay Road in an easterly direction for approximately 124 meters.	8.15am until 9.15am 2.45pm until 3.45pm on every school day.
