

NOTICE OF VARIATION (NO 2) - OFF STREET PARKING PLACES 2023

Dorset Council in exercise of powers under Section 35C and 46A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and in compliance with Regulation 25 (Part V) Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 intends to vary "The Dorset Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2022" to introduce the following tariff and operational changes:
