THE DORSET COUNCIL (FAIRFIELD ROAD AND RASHLEY ROAD, CHICKERELL) (SCHOOL STREET) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) (EXPERIMENTAL ORDER) 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Dorset Council Traffic Manager, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police hereby modify the experimental traffic order named above.

The Dorset Council (Fairfield Road and Rashley road, Chickerell) (School Street) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (Experimental Order) 2023 is modified as follows:

The restricted hours implemented by the experimental order to apply between the hours 8.15 to 8.45 am and 2.45 to 3.15pm Monday to Friday on every school day.

The modification to the Order will come into operation on 4th September 2023 and will remain in force for the duration of the Experimental Order.
