TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDERS 1977-1983

WHEREAS: Wimborne District Council being the appropriate Local Planning Authority within the meaning of Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Orders 1977-1983 are of the opinion that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on land at West Moors Wimborne Dorset being the land shown edged red on the plan annexed hereto unless permission therefor is granted on an application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Orders 1977-1983

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the said Article 4 HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Orders 1977-1983 shall not apply to development on the said land of the description set out in the Schedule hereto

This Direction is made in pursuance of the provisions of paragraph 2 of the said Article 4 and shall not come into force until it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment

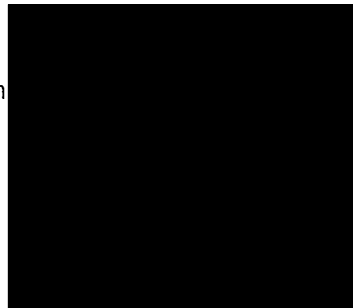
SCHEDULE

The use of land ~~(other than a building or the curtilage of a building) for any purpose or purposes except as a caravan site on not more than 28 days in total in any calendar year (of which not more than 14 days in total may be devoted to use for on not more than 14 days in total in any calendar year for~~

the purpose of motor car or motor cycle racing ~~or for the~~  
~~purpose of the holding of markets) and the erection or placing~~  
~~of moveable structures on the land for the purposes of that~~  
~~use~~; being development comprised within Class IV specified in  
Schedule 1 to The Town and Country Planning General  
Development Order 1977 and not being development comprised  
within any other class .

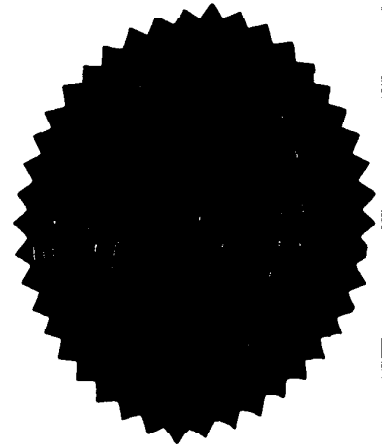
