

LAND SOUTH OF TRUNK ROAD A.31, ST. LEONARDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 29th day of December, 1972 the Secretary of State for the Environment approved a Direction made by the County Council, as Local Planning Authority, under Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1963 to the effect that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to the carrying out of the following classes of development on land south of Trunk Road A.31 at St. Leonards, more particularly described in the schedule to this Notice:-

- "(1) The use of land (other than a building or the curtilage of a building or the site or curtilage of a building which has been demolished in consequence of war damage) for any purpose except as a caravan site on not more than 28 days in total in any calendar year, and the erection or placing of moveable structures on the land for the purposes of that use
 - (2) The use of land, other than buildings and not within the curtilage of a dwelling house, for the purposes of recreation or instruction by members of an organisation which holds a certificate of exemption granted by the Minister of Housing and Local Government under Section 269 of the Public Health Act, 1936, and the erection or placing of tents on the land for the purposes of that use
- (3) The use of land, other than a building, as a caravan site in any of the circumstances specified in Paragraphs 2 to 9 (inclusive) of the First Schedule to the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act, 1960, or in the circumstances (other than those relating to winter quarters) specified in Paragraph 10 of the said Schedule."

being respectively development specified in classes IV(2), V and XXII of the First Schedule to the Order.

The general effect of the Direction is that planning permission must now be obtained before ${\color{blue}\boldsymbol{-}}$

- (a) using the land for any temporary purpose, including erecting moveable structures on the land for that temporary purpose;
- (b) using the land for the purpose of recreation or instruction by members of recreational organisations, including erecting tents on the land for that purpose; and
- (c) stationing any caravans on the land.

This Direction comes into force on the Ath February, 1973.

(1) Article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1963 (hereinafter called "the Order") permits the following development (inter alia) being development specified in the First Schedule to the Order:-

(i) Class IV(2) Temporary uses

The use of land (other than a building or the curtilage of a building or the site or curtilage of a building which has been demolished in consequence of war damage) for any purpose except as a caravan site on not more than 28 days in total in any calendar year, and the erection or placing of moveable structures on the land for the purposes of that use

(ii) Class V Uses by members of recreational organisations

The use of land, other than buildings and not within the curtilage of a dwelling house, for the purposes of recreation or instruction by members of an organisation which holds a certificate of exemption granted by the Minister of Housing and Local Government under Section 269 of the Public Health Act, 1936, and the erection or placing of tents on the land for the purposes of that use

(iii) Class XXII Use as caravan site

The use of land, other than a building, as a caravan site in any of the circumstances specified in Paragraphs 2 to 9 (inclusive) of the First Schedule to the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act, 1960, or in the circumstances (other than those relating to winter quarters) specified in Paragraph 10 of the said Schedule.

- (2) The Hampshire County Council (hereinafter called "the Council") are the Local Planning Authority for the land specified in the Second Schedule hereto
- (3) The Council are satisfied that it is expedient that the development specified in the First Schedule hereto should not be carried out on the land specified in the Second Schedule hereto unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Order
- NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Order HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to the development specified in the First Schedule hereto in respect of the land specified in the Second Schedule hereto

All development specified in Classes IV(2), V & XXII of the First Schedule to the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1963.

SECOND SCHEDULE
