1. Article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General

unit of building or engineering operations requisite for the
use of that land for the purpose of agriculture being Class
VI(1) of the First Schedule to the Order
2. The Works specified in the First Schedule hereto are
development within the said Class VI(1) of the First Schedule
to the Order
3. The Wimborne District Council (hereinafter called "the
Council") are the appropriate Local Planning Authority for the
land specified in the Second Schedule hereto (hereinafter
called "the said land")
4. The Council are satisfied that it is expedient that the
said development within the said Class VI(1) should not be
carried out on the said land unless permission therefor is
granted on application made under the Order
NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred
upon them by Article 4 of the Order HEREBY DIRECT that the
permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not
apply to the development specified in the First Schedule
hereto in respect of the said land


THE FIRST SCHEDULE

The carrying out on the said land of works for the excavation and construction of fish farms or agricultural reservoirs being engineering operations requisite for the use of the said land for the purposes of agriculture and being development comprised within Class VI(1) of the Order and not being development comprised within any other Class
