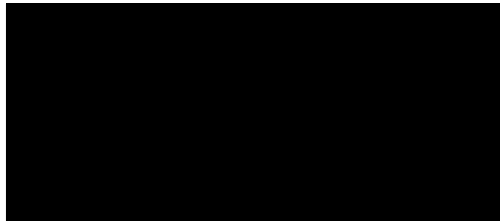

SUBJECT

Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950.

I forward herewith one copy of a Direction made by the County Council under the provisions of Article IV of the above Order in respect of land at Lower Common and Three Legged Cross, Verwood. The Direction has been approved by the Minister of Housing and Local Government and will come into force on the date of the publication of the attached Notice which will be on Friday next, the 1st October, 1954.

Copies of the Notice and of the Direction have been sent to the Wimborne and Cranborne Rural District Council for registration in the local Land Charges Register and for showing to any interested persons.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER, 1950

WHEREAS the County Council of the Administrative County of Dorset being the local planning authority for the said County are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be undertaken on the land shown edged pink on the plan annexed hereto and numbered 4/4/10 unless permission therefor is granted on an application made in that behalf under the Town and Country General Development Order, 1950.

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country General Development Order, 1950, hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the description set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

The carrying out of building or engineering operations for the purposes of agriculture being development comprised within Class VI(1) referred to in Part I of the First Schedule to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other Class.

**Direction made by Dorset County Council**  
**under Article 3**  
**Lower Common, Verwood.**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Dorset County Council has with the approval of the Minister of Housing and Local Government issued a Direction dated the 29th day of September, 1953 prohibiting any development of the descriptions set out in the Schedule hereto on land at Lower Common and Three Legged Cross situated in the Rural District of Wimborne and Cranborne described below and shown edged pink on the map annexed thereto and numbered 4/4/10, unless permission therefor is granted on an application made in that behalf under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950.

The land referred to is bounded on the West by the railway line from West Moors Junction to Salisbury;

on the South by the Southern boundaries of fields numbered 200, in the parish of Holt, fields numbered 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 111, 114, 115, 116, 117, 118, in the parish of West Parley, fields numbered 1046, 1049, 1050, 1055, in the parish of Verwood and the Moors River;

on the East by the County boundary and the Eastern boundaries of fields numbered 1054, 1052, 708, 1033, 760, in the parish of Verwood;

and on the North by an irregular line running along the Northern and Eastern boundaries of fields numbered 374 and 380 in the parish of Horton, field numbered 781, the Southern boundaries of fields numbered 782, 788, 789, the Eastern boundaries of fields numbered 789, 790, 792, the Eastern boundaries of field numbered 769, the Northern boundaries of fields numbered 716, 714, 713, 711, the Eastern boundary of Verwood Road and thence across field numbered 668, to Potterne Farm buildings and to the Northern boundaries of fields numbered 708, and 681 in the parish of Verwood (Dorset Ordnance Sheets XXVI: 3, 4, 7, 8, 11, and 12 - Second Edition 1901).

A copy of the said Direction and of the map defining the land to which it relates may be seen during usual office hours at the offices of the Wimborne and Cranborne Rural District Council, Furzehill, Wimborne, at the East Area Planning Office, Civic Centre, East Borough, Wimborne and at the County Hall, Dorchester.

And notice is hereby given that the said Direction will come into force on the date of publication of this advertisement.

The carrying out on agricultural land having an area of more than one acre and comprised in an agricultural unit of building or engineering operations requisite for the use of the land for the purpose of agriculture being development comprised within Class VI(1) referred to in the First Schedule to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other Class.
