GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDERS 1973-1974 6

WHEREAS: the Council of the District of Wimborne being the appropriate Local Planning Authority within the meaning of Article 4 of the Town and As amended Country Planning General Development Order 1973 are of the opinion that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on land at Wigbeth Farm, Horton, Near Wimborne being the land shown edged red on the plan annexed hereto unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973, as a manded.

AND WHEREAS: the Council are further of the opinion that development of the said descriptions would be prejudicial to the proper planning of their area and would constitute a threat to the amenities of their area and that the provisions of paragraph 3(b) of the said Article 4 should apply to this direction.

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the said Article 4 hereby direct that the permission granted by Article as a mender 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973 shall not apply to development on the said land of the descriptions set out in the Schedule hereto.


This direction is made in pursuance of the provisions of paragraph 3(b) of the said Article 4 and shall remain in force until the 7th December 1975 (being 6 months from the date of this direction) and will then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment before that date.

SCHEDULE

The use of land (other than a building or the curtilage of a building) for any purpose or purposes except as a caravan site on not more than 28 days in total in any calendar year (of which not more than 14 days in total may be devoted to use for the purpose of motor car or motor cycle racing or for the purpose of the holding of markets) and the erection or placing of removable structures on the land for the purposes of that use.

Being development comprised within class IV referred to in Schedule 1 to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other class.
