NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon the local planning authority by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950, and delegated to them as aforesaid, on behalf of the said Dorset County Council the local planning authority, hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the descriptions set out in the Schedule hereto.
