TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1977-81

Direction under Article 4 regarding land at  
Verlands Road, Weymouth

W H E R E A S :-

(1) The Borough Council of Weymouth and Portland (hereinafter called "the Council") being the local planning authority is satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on land situated at OS Plan Reference SY 7183 SW at Verlands Road Weymouth in the County of Dorset which land is more particularly delineated and edged Pink on the plan annexed hereto unless permission therefore is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 on the grounds that the said development would be prejudicial to the proper planning of the area and would constitute a threat to the amenities of the area.

NOW THEREFORE:-

1. The Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order of 1977 shall not apply to development on the said land of the description set out in the Schedule hereto.

## SCHEDULE

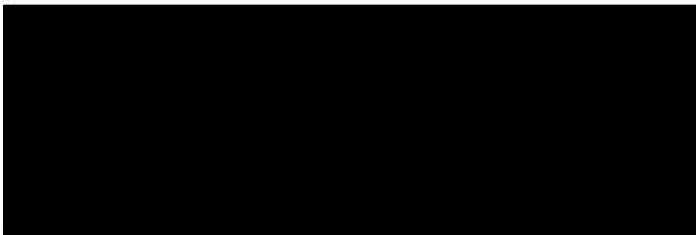
The use of the said land (other than a building or a curtilage of a building) for the purpose of camping, ~~er~~ tenting ~~or~~ ~~any like activity~~ including the erection or placing of moveable structures on the land for the purpose of that use not more than 28 days in total in any calendar year being development comprised within Class IV (2) as referred to in Schedule 1 of the said Order of 1977 and not being development comprised within any other Class.
