I was horrified to note that the property I own, namely THE FIELD OPPOSITE THE PUB IN BRADFORD ABBAS, has many mentions as if it's to be considered for designation as a green space and the plan also infers The Field should be available for public use.

The Bradford Abbas Parish Council approached me earlier in the year on this matter and I made it quite clear to them that The Field was not to be included in their application for it to become a green space and I am attaching a copy of my letter to them.

The BA Parish Council has been harassing me over the past few years and I am not happy about the level of pressure they have put on me to get some control of The Field.

I would reiterate that THE FIELD is solely owned by me for use by my family, members of whom maintain it, and anyone else I authorise to use it. I would also point out that I do not rent it out at all.

I expect The Field to be excluded from the Plan and no further action taken.

To the Members of the Parish Council

I refer to your letter dated 15th March 2026 detailing your proposal to designate the land I own to the south of Church Road opposite the Rose and Crown Pub as a Local Green Space.

This issue has been raised in the past when I said no and my answer this time is still **NO**. I find it hard to believe that the Parish Council can propose this course of action by discussing and including it on your list of areas you want protected without first obtaining my views.

This land is for use by me and my family and I do not want the Parish Council telling me what I can and cannot do with it.

Regarding your reasons for doing it, it neither has access to nor view of the River Yeo and hence I do not see it as having distinctive character. The only thing that makes the field appealing is the fact it is well looked after by my family.

Will you therefore withdraw my land from your list of proposed applications.
