Temporary Closure of Kings Mill Lane, Stalbridge

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Kings Mill Lane, Stalbridge at Kings Mill Bridge (in both directions), a distance of approximately 30 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 7 October 2024 and will remain in force for 18 months and can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport if necessary; however, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 29 November 2024.

This Order will enable Dorset Council Highways to carry out works to the stone retaining wall at Kings Mill Bridge.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.

Temporary Closure of Pilwell, Marnhull

DORSET COUNCIL intend, not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Pilwell, Marnhull between Burton Street and Nash Lane (in both directions), a distance of approximately 140 metres. The order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 7 October 2024 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 1 November 2024.

This Order will enable Wessex Water to replace the existing water main with a reinforcement main. An alternative vehicular route will be signed using Pilwell, Sodom Lane, B3092 Salisbury Street, Church Hill and vice versa.

The County of Dorset Traffic Management Scheme (Various Roads, Shaftesbury) (No.*) Order 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of Dorset proposes to make the above-mentioned Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

The general effect of the Order will be to introduce the following restrictions:

- Prohibit any vehicle (except local buses and pedal cycles) to enter or proceed on a section along Mampitts Road, Shaftesbury.
- Prohibit any vehicle to turn left (except local buses and pedal cycles) from Pound Lane onto Mampitts Road, Shaftesbury.

Under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 Dorset Council hereby gives notice that it proposes to introduce two road humps in Mampitts Road, Shaftesbury (3.5m long and 75mm high). The road humps will be constructed to the Department for Transport specification. Relevant exemptions will apply where appropriate and as necessary in accordance with the provisions of the Order.


