## FORMAL OBJECTION TO PROPOSED INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT

I wish to register very strong objections to this proposed development, for the following reasons:

- 1. The area borders on Lorton Nature Reserve and any industrial development will undoubtedly adversely affect wild life.
- 2. Much of the area is sports fields, the loss of which will be the loss of a valuable amenity.
- 3. Weymouth Bay Avenue is unsuitable as an access road as it is already busy with domestic traffic, it is a residential area which will suffer an increase in traffic, including Heavy Goods Vehicles (HGV), with consequent increases in road hazard, accidents, noise, and air pollution.
- 4. The junction of Weymouth Bay Avenue with the Dorchester Road is very narrow and unsuitable for the extra traffic, especially HGVs.
- 5. The area is liable to flooding and to sewage problems, with a sewage pumping station and sewage pipe running through the site. Development will make the problem worse.
- 6. Industrial development will be damaging to Lorton Valley Park and will impede access to both the park and nature reserve by walkers.
- 7. There is wildlife in the area, including deer and bats, and the development would destroy wild life habitat.
- 8. There is no need of an industrial development in the centre of this residential and park area, and there is certainly no local support!
