The whole concept of building an "Island Development " on the top of a hill is misconceived, as the only way down from the "Island " is the narrow Wyke Oliver road through the existing urbanisation. Cars are already parked on one side causing one way traffic. There would be traffic chaos on this road as everyone would be attempting to use Wyke Oliver road to gain access to the main Preston road.
