

THE COUNTY OF DORSET (WHITE WAY, LITTON CHENEY) (WEIGHT RESTRICTION) (NO.4) ORDER 2026

Dorset Council in exercise of powers under Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of the Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle in excess of 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight (except for access) to proceed in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in the roads referred to in that Article, if the vehicle:-
 - (a) requires to be loaded or unloaded to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that road;
 - (b) cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations namely:-
 - i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic
 - iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road;
 - iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or on land adjacent to the said lengths of roads of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunication Act 1984 (Chapter 12)
 - (c) cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) is to be used for the purposes of delivering or collecting postal packets to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that road as defined in Section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000;
 - (e) is to be used for fire bridge, ambulance or police emergency purposes;
 - (f) is being used for the conveyance of, goods or merchandise, to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that road;

- (g) is to be used to convey, collect or transfer household waste to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that road.
 - (h) is to be used by buses, coaches and other public service vehicles.
 - (i) The vehicle is being used for the purpose of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to or with access from the length of road specified in the schedule of this Order.
3. This Order may be cited as 'The County of Dorset (White Way, Litton Cheney) (Weight Restriction) (No.4) Order 2026' and shall come into operation on the 2nd day of October 2026.
