

## **DORSET COUNCIL TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT SCHEME, CHICKERELL ROAD, CHICKERELL**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of Dorset proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

The general effect of the order will be to:

- Introduce no waiting at any time restrictions along parts of Chickerell Road, Chickerell
- Introduce no loading at any time restrictions along parts of Chickerell Road, Chickerell
- Formalise the school keep clear markings along part of Chickerell Road, Chickerell (outside of the entrance to Budmouth Academy)

As part of the traffic management scheme, Dorset Council in exercise of powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intends to:

- Install a new signalised toucan crossing along Chickerell Road, Chickerell (near to the entrance to Budmouth Academy).
