I have two concerns about the Wyke Oliver / Brackendown development. First is the destruction of a green field site which is already less able to hold the excess of rainfall which is becoming apparent with the changing climate. Even now, the land and properties, especially garages, below this area are experiencing flooding during heavy rainfall and, being built on clay, the area could start to suffer from landslip which will cause all manner of problems with existing buildings being prone to subsidence. Reducing the amount of pristine land over this development area will only exacerbate the risk. There is not enough green space already to absorb the excess of rainwater.
