- 1. Environmental and Ecological Concerns:
  - **Biodiversity**: Destruction of irreplaceable trees, hedgerows, and watercourses; loss of habitat for diverse plants and wildlife, including birds and otters.
  - Climate Change: Increased risks of flooding and fires, with minimal impact from additional drainage and access issues for emergency services.

### 2. Proximity to RSPB Lodmoor and SSSI:

• Adjacent to RSPB Lodmoor, providing critical habitat for birds. Disturbance could lead to legal and financial repercussions.

### 3. Access and Congestion:

• Heavily used access routes could be restricted, deterring visitors and impacting the local economy. Increased congestion complicates emergency vehicle access and deliveries.
