

Summer Reading Challenge Champion volunteer role

Role may include:

- helping to register children
- encouraging children to take part in the Summer Reading Challenge
- explaining to families how the challenge works
- encouraging children to talk about what they have been reading
- giving out stickers and updating records
- helping children to choose books to take home
- helping children to use the Summer Reading Challenge website
- using activity sheets and other resources to help children to share their reading choices with their peers
- helping to prepare and assist with crafts and children's activities
- helping with various tasks to create a welcoming children's library area

Skills and experience:

- calm under pressure
- a good team worker
- enthusiastic about encouraging children to read
- good at engaging with people of all ages
- reliable and punctual
- adaptable and happy to learn new skills

Training and support:

A member of the library team will welcome you into the library, providing an induction and orientation around the library, health and safety training and training for the role.

A designated member of the library team will be your main contact.

All volunteer placements include a review, typically conducted after 3 to 4 sessions, depending on how frequently you volunteer. This review is an opportunity to check in, ensure the role is meeting your expectations, and provide any support you may need. The overall length of your placement will be agreed upon at the start.
