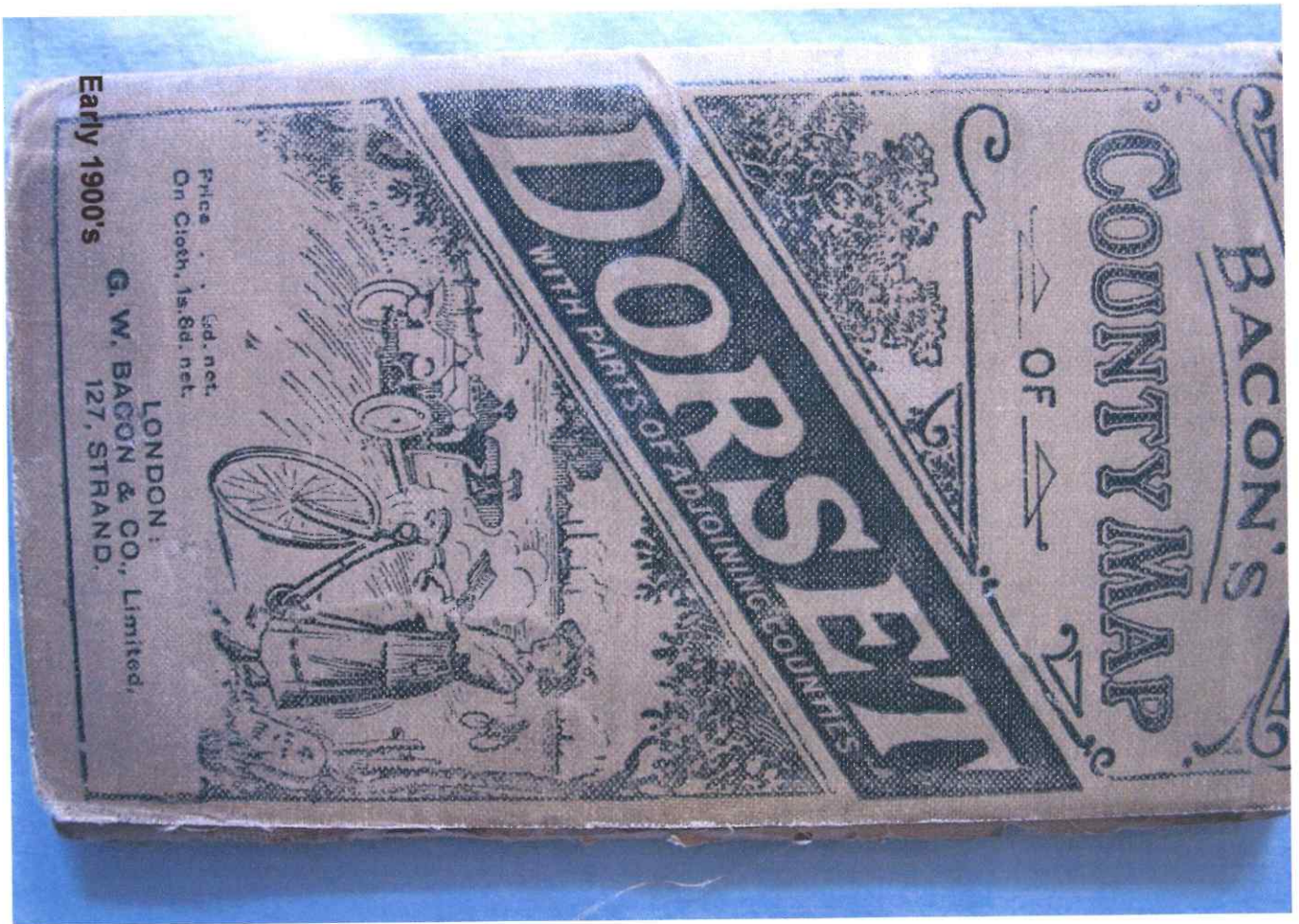














Richmond's Map of Dorset
