I refer to our letter of 8 February 2024 and enclose a copy of a notice of the Inspector's proposal to modify the above-mentioned Order in accordance with paragraph 8(2) of Schedule 15 to the above Act, together with a copy of the Order as submitted and a copy of the Order showing the proposed modifications.

We will arrange for the notice to be advertised in the Swanage and Wareham Advertiser on Thursday 28 March 2024.

Your Council should:

1. Arrange for a copy of the notice and Order map to be displayed in a prominent position at each end of the path, not later than the date on which the notice first appears in the press.
2. Place the notice, a copy of the Order as made, a copy of the Order showing the proposed modifications and a copy of the Inspector's interim decision on deposit at your Council's offices and all other offices where the original notice was publicised.

If you wish to make an objection to the Inspector's proposed modifications, you must ensure that it is submitted between 28 March 2024 and 25 April 2024. Any objections received outside these dates will not be 'duly made'. A 'duly made' objection is one which is received within the period set out in the notice of modification and, according to the judgment in *Marriott v Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions 2001*, must be with respect to the Inspector's proposals.

Only objections received within these dates will ensure your right to be heard.
