## **Issue 2 Climate Change and the Natural Environment**

The AONB is particularly pleased to see, and **support**, the amendment to paragraph 4.64 and Policy 4 relating to the need for developers to demonstrate that their proposals have taken account of the relevant Management Plan for the AONB.

This is particularly important as the AONB Management Plan has been adopted by North Dorset District Council and other partners in the AONB Partnership.

The adopted AONB Management Plan also seeks to have consistent policies for the AONB across the partner Planning Authorities (Policy PT 2).

*Encourage and contribute to coherent and consistent formulation and implementation of planning policies, including across Local Authority boundaries, to ensure they take full account of the local distinctiveness, character and quality of the AONB and its setting.*

Wiltshire Council, which covers 62% of the AONB, has already adopted a similar policy in their Core Strategy that has been through the Examination process.
